Class Policies:

Studio Safety Guideline

- Always follow the instruction of your teacher.
- Please ask before using equipment or tools.
- Please ask for help during glazing.
- Use caution in the studio when the kiln is firing.
- Proper attire such as apron, long hair tied back, etc..
- Keep your workspace clean and free of dust by using a wet sponge.
- Please keep food away from your workspace and the studio.
- Please try to give your studio mates ample space.
- Masks are appreciated but optional.
